
A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE FORMATION OF THE COUNCIL IN CAMBODIA

The horrific event of the 2001 September 11 attack on the World Trade Center brought about deep worries and various measures have been taken to prevent such a terrorist attack from happening again.

In the middle of 2002, Kofi Annan, then-Secretary General of the United Nations (UN), sent Dr. William F.

This meeting was at Chaktumuk conference hall, Phnom penh, cambodia, 10 oct. 2002



The opening ceremony of formation of the Council took place on the 10th of October 2002, 8:30 am until 12 am at Chatomuk Theater of Phnom Penh. The ceremony was graced by the presence of Minister Kong Samol, the deputy minister of the Royal Palace representing King Father Norodom Sihanouk.

The ceremony also featured the recitation of prayers. A welcome speech had been made to welcome the minister of the Ministry of Cults and Religion and the Secretary General of the WCRP.

Later on, high profile speakers highlighted the way of building of peace. All representatives of the main religions, the founders in Cambodia were determined to put ideas together towards peace.




Opening Jayanto chanting by monk




Openning prayer by Islam and catholic and protestant

The Joint Statement by Cambodian Religious Leaders On the Occasion of the Inauguration of Cambodian Interreligious Council (CIC)/WCRP

10 October 2002, Phnom Penh

We, the leaders of Buddhist, Muslim, Christian and other religious communities in Cambodia:

REMEMBER that the Cambodian people have undergone unbearable suffering from war and violence, which damaged individuals and their societies at all levels and resulted in trauma, poverty and the loss of religious values,

BELIEVE that reviving religious values, faith and practice will enable people to overcome their wounds and pains from the past and to gain strength and wisdom to reconstruct their family, society and nation,

RECOGNIZE the important role of religious communities in reconciliation, peace education, and economic and social development,

COMMIT ourselves to rebuilding our respective faith traditions and their communities with respect for freedom of religion and the rejection of pressure or coercion to convert from one religion to another,

COMMIT ourselves to taking the lead in creating a peaceful and harmonious society based upon our shared values and commitments,

DECIDE to establish the Cambodian Inter-religious Council (CIC)/a national chapter of the World Conference on Religion and Peace (WCRP) as an instrument of interreligious collaboration for peace,

COMMIT ourselves to undertaking cooperative action through CIC to address issues of common concerns such as development, peace education, democracy and human rights, eradication of small arms, prevention of HIV/AIDS, and preservation of the environment,

COMMIT ourselves, through CIC, to entering into partnership with relevant public and civil society institutions and groups including governments, the United Nations, and NGOs,

PLEDGE ourselves to nurturing a culture of peace, mutual respect and understanding, harmonious common living, and working together for peace and social development.


